NO WEAK LINKS

These elegant necklaces come in a variety of styles, including the popular anchor chain and figaro (which usually features an alternating pattern of one large and three small links). A chain link that has been twisted and then flattened is often called a "curb link." Link chains also come in a variety of sizes, ranging from the small, basic chain known as the cable, commonly used for small pendants, to larger, striking necklaces and bracelets. Normally, the thicker the link, the

stronger it is, provided it is solid and well-soldered.
